At the Nonpartisan Office and Referendum Spring Election to be held on Tuesday, April 1, 2025, in the Town of Spring Brook, Dunn County, Wisconsin, the electors within Wards 1-3 will vote at the Spring Brook Town Hall (N3519 810<sup>th</sup> Street; [rural] Elk Mound, WI) for State, Judicial, Municipal, and School District offices and a State Referendum.
